UGC SAP DSA-III


Applications are invited for the post of Project Fellow under the UGC Special Assistance Programme (SAP) at the level of DSA-III sanctioned vide letter No.F-4-3 (DSA-III)/2015 (SAP-III) dated 20.4.2015 for a period of 5 years w.e.f. 1.4.2015. The position is purely temporary and co-terminus with the duration of the project.


Minimum Essential Qualification: The candidate to be considered for appointment of Project Fellow must have a minimum of Second Class (55% marks or equivalent CGPA, 50% in case of SC/ST/PH) at Master Degree M.Phil Degree in English. The candidate appointed as Project Fellow may be enrolled for Ph.D degree if NET/SLET qualified. For further terms and conditions kindly refer to the rules available on the UGC website.

Age limit: The Candidates should be below the age of 40 years at the time of application.

Remuneration: Consolidated salary of Rs.14,000/- per month for initial 2 years & Rs.18000/- per month from the 3rd year onwards plus HRA (for Non-Gate/Non NET Candidates) and Rs.16,000/- per month for initial 2 years & Rs.18000/- per month from the 3rd year onwards plus HRA (for Gate/GPAT/NET Candidates) as per University norms (as per new UGC guidelines).

How to apply: Eligible candidates may apply with full details on plain paper (including qualifications, age, e-mail ID, contact no. etc. along with details of certificate of qualifications, experience if any) so as to reach the undersigned within a week from the date of the advertisement. The applications will be scrutinized on the basis of qualification, experience and suitability of the candidate in the programme. Only short listed candidates from the initial screening will be called for interview. No further communication on this matter will be entertained.
